Introduction

You are invited to be a participant in a research study that examines the scholarly communications and publishing practices of Bucknell University faculty members. Please read this page carefully before agreeing to participate in the study. This study is being conducted by the Research Services Group of the Bertrand Library.

Purpose of this Research

The purpose of this study is to obtain an author-centered understanding of the processes involved in the creation and dissemination of scholarly research publications and to identify unmet faculty needs within these processes.
